Community Economic Empowerment Through the Development of Situ Tunggilis Tourism in Situsari Village, Cileungsi District, Bogor Regency

This study presents the outcomes of a community-based tourism development program implemented in Situ Tunggilis, Situsari Village, Bogor Regency, Indonesia, from July 2022 to June 2024. Collaborating with the Village-Owned Enterprises (BUMDes), Situsari Village Government, and various local community groups was crucial throughout the program phases, ensuring smooth operations and alignment with the village's needs and potentials. The study involved initial surveys, needs analyses, training sessions, infrastructure development, promotional activities, and monitoring and evaluation. Results show a significant increase in tourist visits, particularly after promotional efforts and infrastructure enhancements. However, fluctuations in visitor numbers were observed throughout the program period, suggesting the need for further stabilization. The satisfaction survey revealed positive feedback from tourists, emphasizing cleanliness, service quality, and facility availability. Nevertheless, challenges such as funding limitations for infrastructure development and community engagement persisted, affecting project timelines and local participation. Despite these challenges, the collaborative approach between stakeholders facilitated a conducive environment for tourism development. Continued evaluation and improvement are necessary to ensure sustainable and impactful tourism activities. This study contributes to the literature on community-based tourism development and offers insights into addressing challenges and maximizing opportunities in similar contexts.

ABSTRAK

A. INTRODUCTION

Situsari Village, located in Bogor Regency, is one of the villages with remarkable natural potential, especially with the presence of Situ Tunggilis. Situ Tunggilis is a natural lake that holds beauty and biodiversity, with great potential to be developed as a tourist destination. The development of tourism in this area aims not only to attract visitors but also to positively impact the local economy.

According to Abreu et al. (2024), community-based tourism development can be an effective tool for improving the economic welfare of local communities. Through direct involvement in the tourism industry, the community can earn additional income and improve their quality of life. However, this significant potential has not been fully utilized. Most residents of Situsari

Village still rely on the agricultural sector with relatively low and unstable incomes. This indicates an urgent need for economic diversification through the tourism sector.

Through a community service program focused on community-based tourism development, it is hoped that new, more sustainable, and profitable economic opportunities can be created for the villagers. Research conducted by Riyanto et al. (2023) shows that community-based tourism can increase local participation and provide significant economic impacts if managed properly. This program is also expected to reduce the community's dependence on the agricultural sector, which is vulnerable to climate and market fluctuations.

The development of community-based tourism in Situ Tunggilis will involve all community members in every stage, from planning, implementation, to management. This approach aims to ensure that the economic benefits of the tourism sector are directly felt by the local community and encourage their active participation in maintaining and preserving the natural environment. This is in line with the views of Anwar et al. (2024), who emphasize the importance of community involvement in tourism management to achieve economic and environmental sustainability.

This program will be implemented in collaboration with the Village-Owned Enterprise (BUMDes) Wijaya Kusuma, which has a strategic role in managing the village's economic potential. With the support of BUMDes, it is expected that the development of Situ Tunggilis tourism can run professionally and sustainably. Research by Permatasari and Sari (2022) shows that the presence of BUMDes can strengthen the village economy through various economic initiatives, including tourism. This collaboration also creates synergy between the village government and the community, making the development program more effective.

Through tourism-based economic empowerment, it is hoped that Situsari Village can experience improved welfare, reduced unemployment, and increased quality of life for the community. This program will also provide training and assistance to the community in various aspects, such as tourism business management, tourist services, and environmental conservation. Research by Wardhana et al. (2021) states that proper training and assistance can enhance the community's capacity to manage tourist destinations and provide adequate services to tourists. This training covers various aspects, from financial management to marketing strategies and customer service.

In addition to training, this program also focuses on developing tourism infrastructure in Situ Tunggilis. Facilities such as walkways, parking areas, and other public facilities will be built or improved to enhance tourist comfort and safety. Research by Jamal and Camargo (2020) shows that adequate infrastructure is crucial to attract tourists and support sustainable tourism. Therefore, investing in infrastructure will not only improve the tourist experience but also contribute to increasing community income.

Therefore, the development of Situ Tunggilis tourism will not only be a new source of income for the residents of Situsari Village but also a strategic step in preserving the natural environment and local culture. This program is expected to become a model for community-based tourism development that can be applied in other villages in Indonesia. Moreover, with sustainable support and regular evaluations, the tourism potential of Situsari Village can continue to grow, providing broader economic and social benefits to the local community. Regular evaluations will be conducted to ensure that this program runs according to plan and delivers the expected positive impact.

Overall, community-based tourism development in Situ Tunggilis is an essential step in improving the welfare of the Situsari Village community. With support from various parties and a commitment to environmental conservation, this program is expected to bring sustainable positive change. It is a model that demonstrates how tourism can play a role in local economic development without sacrificing environmental sustainability.

B. IMPLEMENTATION METHOD

This program is carried out in collaboration with the Village-Owned Enterprise (BUMDes) Wijaya Kusuma, the Situsari Village Government, and various local community groups. These partners play a crucial role in every stage of the activities, from planning to evaluation. The support from BUMDes and the village government ensures that the program runs smoothly and aligns with the village's needs and potential. Research by Abreu et al. (2024) supports the importance of collaboration between village governments and BUMDes in the success of community empowerment programs.

The activities span 24 months, from July 2022 to June 2024, in Situsari Village, Cileungsi District, Bogor Regency, particularly in the Situ Tunggilis tourism area. The timing and location were chosen based on an analysis of tourism potential and the needs of the local community. According to Permatasari and Sari (2022), a sufficiently long implementation period allows for significant changes in community economic empowerment through tourism.

The implementation stages begin with planning and preparation during the first and second months. These activities include initial surveys and needs analysis to understand the current conditions, tourism potential, and community needs. Subsequently, coordination meetings are held with BUMDes Wijaya Kusuma, the Village Government, and community groups to develop a work plan. This stage also involves procuring the necessary tools and materials for the program's execution, such as training equipment, promotional materials, and tourism support tools. Suzuki et al. (2021) emphasize the importance of initial surveys and needs analysis to ensure the program is targeted and effective in community empowerment.

From the third to the sixth month, the program focuses on training and capacity building for the community. The training provided includes tourism business management, tourist services, and environmental conservation. Tourism business management training helps the community with administration, finance, and tourism business marketing. Tourist service training enhances communication skills and the community's knowledge of tourist attractions, while environmental conservation training provides an understanding of the importance of maintaining the cleanliness and beauty of Situ Tunggilis. Kristiana et al. (2020) found that community training and capacity building can significantly improve the quality of service and tourism management.

The tourism program implementation begins from the seventh to the twelfth month. These activities include developing tourism infrastructure together with BUMDes, such as building or improving walkways, parking areas, and other public facilities. Additionally, promotional materials such as brochures, posters, and social media content are created and disseminated to attract tourists. The program also organizes events or tourist attractions that involve active community participation, such as cultural festivals or recreational activities. Research by Jamal and Camargo (2020) shows that effective infrastructure development and promotion are crucial in attracting tourists and boosting the local economy. Slamet & Juvoni (2023) also found that social media and tourism events can increase tourist visit interest.

From the thirteenth to the twenty-fourth month, the program enters the monitoring and evaluation phase. Regular evaluations are conducted to assess the program's progress and identify areas needing improvement. Tourist satisfaction surveys are collected to gauge their satisfaction and highlight areas for enhancement. Subsequently, a final report is prepared, covering the program's results, challenges faced, and recommendations for sustainability. Persaud and Dagher (2021) emphasize that regular monitoring and evaluation are crucial for assessing the program's effectiveness and making necessary continuous improvements.

Evaluation instruments used include questionnaires and interviews to gather data from the community, partners, and tourists about the program's effectiveness and their satisfaction.

Direct observation during activity implementation ensures that each stage proceeds as planned. Periodic reports document the program's progress, key findings, and necessary follow-up steps. Clarke et al. (2022) highlight the importance of comprehensive evaluation instruments to measure the real impact of community empowerment programs.

Materials and tools used in this program include training modules, promotional brochures and posters, office supplies, construction materials for tourism infrastructure, projectors and laptops for training presentations, cameras for documentation, cleaning equipment, and communication tools such as radios and mobile phones. With comprehensive implementation methods and the involvement of various parties, this program successfully achieved the goal of community economic empowerment through effective and sustainable tourism development in Situ Tunggilis.

This program also provides continuous training for the community to manage and promote Situ Tunggilis tourism. This training involves experts in tourism, marketing, and business management. The community is trained to manage homestays, open food stalls, and provide tour guide services. Additionally, training includes aspects of tourist safety and comfort, including first aid and emergency handling.

Furthermore, the program encourages active involvement of youth and women in tourism economic activities. Youth are involved in digital promotion through social media, while women are empowered through skills training such as cooking, handicrafts, and homestay management. This not only enhances their skills and income but also strengthens their roles in the community.

Through community-based tourism development in Situ Tunggilis, it is expected to create a model that can be replicated in other villages in Indonesia. The program's success shows that with careful planning, strong collaboration, and active community participation, tourism development can be an effective tool for improving the economic welfare and quality of life of village communities. This program not only provides direct economic impacts but also encourages environmental and cultural preservation, creating a sustainable and attractive tourist destination for both domestic and international tourists.

C. DISCUSSION

The results of the activities carried out during the period from July 2022 to June 2024 have led to significant achievements in the development of tourism in Situ Tunggilis, Situsari Village. Based on survey data and evaluations conducted at the end of the program, there has been an increase in the number of tourists visiting, especially after intensive efforts in tourism promotion and infrastructure development. Measures such as social media promotion, brochure creation, and the implementation of tourism events have successfully attracted tourist interest. Furthermore, the construction of supporting facilities such as pedestrian pathways, adequate parking areas, and other public amenities has enhanced the attractiveness and comfort of this tourist destination.

However, despite the significant increase in the number of tourist visits, there are still fluctuations in the visitation numbers, indicating that the stability of visits has not yet been fully achieved. These fluctuations may be due to several factors, including weather conditions, uneven promotion efforts, and limitations in facilities in certain areas. These challenges need to be addressed with more comprehensive and sustainable strategies to ensure consistent growth in the future.

The importance of collaboration between the village government, BUMDes, and the local community is key to maintaining and enhancing the stability of tourist visits. With continuous efforts and ongoing improvements, Situ Tunggilis has the potential to become a more stable and beneficial tourist destination for the Situsari Village community.

The results of the evaluation from the tourist satisfaction survey indicate that the majority of respondents expressed satisfaction with their tourism experience at Situ Tunggilis. Factors such as cleanliness, service, and the availability of facilities were rated positively by tourists. However, there were some suggestions highlighting the need for infrastructure improvements, particularly concerning accessibility and safety. Tourists expressed a desire for road improvements leading to the location and enhanced safety signs around the lake. Although this program achieved several commendable achievements, various challenges were encountered during its implementation. One of them was the limited funding available to the BUMDes for development and construction. This resulted in delays in completing infrastructure projects, impacting the experience and satisfaction of tourists. Some projects, such as the construction of sanitation facilities and parking areas, were delayed, reducing comfort for visitors.

Furthermore, another challenge was related to the involvement of the local community in tourism management and promotion. Despite training and coaching efforts, some members of the community were not fully active in supporting tourism development. This indicates the need to continue raising awareness and community participation to preserve and develop the tourism potential. Some residents still lack an understanding of the long-term benefits of tourism development, so their participation in various tourism activities needs further improvement.

The results obtained from this program indicate that community-based tourism development in Situ Tunggilis has great potential to improve the local economy and enhance community welfare. Through collaboration between the village government, BUMDes, and various stakeholders, a conducive environment for tourism development has been created. Support from these parties is crucial in overcoming various challenges and ensuring that the program progresses according to plan.

The significant increase in tourist visits indicates that effective promotion and well-planned infrastructure development can enhance the attractiveness of tourist destinations. Various promotional strategies such as social media usage, brochure creation, and local events have successfully attracted visitors. Additionally, the construction of supporting facilities such as pedestrian paths, adequate parking areas, and other public facilities has increased visitor comfort and satisfaction.

However, it is important to continue with ongoing evaluation and sustainable improvements to ensure that tourism activities are sustainable and have a positive impact on the local community. Regular evaluations must be conducted to assess the effectiveness of the
